GENERAL INFORMATION

- Contact counselors directly (until June 15th), OR **Bruce Hafferkamp** (354-6758 or 354-6734) with specific summer school questions. Find counselor contact phone numbers within this brochure.
- The Library and select 1st floor classrooms will be used. Students should enter daily on Longfellow.
- **Daily attendance is required.** Students missing any class time will greatly jeopardize course completion. In the event of a necessary absence, pre arrangement for make-up work should be made with individual teachers, of course ahead of time!
- Students are expected to be cooperative and on task during class. Any ongoing /serious behavior issues will likely result in dismissal from the SPHS Summer School program.
- **HOMEWORK:** Spending additional time for homework outside of class time helps!. Online access needed.
- There will not be district bus transportation service provided for SPHS summer school.
- **Shadle Summer School campus will be closed by 12:30 pm daily.** Arrangements must be made with administration to remain later than 12:15 pm.
- Textbooks and course materials will be provided, but students should bring paper, pens, pencils, etc.
