

Scholarship searching at Shadle Park High School:

Students should now utilize their Naviance portfolio to search for scholarships. This list is updated throughout the year, so students should continue to look for new scholarships on a monthly basis.

To access their Naviance portfolio, students should do the following:

- Go to Shadle's webpage: www.spokaneschools.org/shadle
- Scroll down and click on the Naviance Family Connection link found in the middle of the page
- Student's user name is: Shadle Student ID
- Student's password is: highlanders (all lowercase)
- Click on the Colleges tab
- Scroll down and click on the link for "scholarship list"

From this list students are encouraged to click on the menu for categories and look up scholarships based on categories that best fit the student. There are many categories to choose from (see the list of them at the end of this document). Scholarships can have more than one category applied to them.

Category choosing recommendations:

- ✓ It is recommended that all seniors view the "Local Area" category as these scholarships are going to be those that would be easier to get because they will have less students applying for them.
- ✓ If you have a specific major in mind, look at the different major interest area categories.
- ✓ Underclassmen are encouraged to look at the category "Grades 9-12". There are scholarships in this category for grades 9-10, grades 11 only and for grades 9-12.
- ✓ Once you have a list of the scholarships in a category, print it out so you can then refer to it.

Scholarship searching recommendations:

- ✓ Click on the name of the scholarship to view a summary of the criteria to see if you qualify.
- ✓ You may need to click on the website where the information for applying for the scholarship may be found, to further determine if you qualify for this scholarship.
- ✓ You can save scholarships to your Naviance portfolio by clicking on the box to the left of the scholarship name on the list and then scrolling down and clicking the "Add Selected Scholarships to My List" link found at the bottom of the page.

Applying to Scholarships recommendations:

- ✓ Pay attention to deadlines, you cannot successfully apply for most scholarships the night before or day of a deadline
- ✓ Most scholarships require a letter of recommendation. You should obtain a form from the counseling center or the College & Career Center to provide to the person you want to recommend you. Ask the recommender at least 2 weeks prior to the scholarship deadline.
- ✓ Never pay money to receive a scholarship, scholarships are free!
- ✓ Have an adult or two proofread your application and/or essay before sending it off.
