



Final Transcripts for seniors

Final transcripts are NOT automatically sent to your college or university, if you need a final transcript sent upon graduation; bring a stamped business envelope to the public office. The envelope should be addressed to the school where you want your transcript sent, and your name/address should be in the upper left hand corner (return address). All fees and fines must be paid before final transcripts can be released. Transcripts will be mailed in early July. Contact the public office at **509-354-6000** with any questions.
