Dear Parent/Guardian:

On the last day of school we will have a supply of your child's medication left at school. For safety reasons, it will be necessary for you to come to school and pick up your child's unused medication. If the medication is not picked up by Monday June 19<sup>th</sup> 2017, it will be disposed of.

Enclosed may be a new form and it will need to be completed and brought in with your child's medication in the fall if your child is to continue to take medication at school. State law requires that schools have this information completed by the physician and parent every year. The medication must be in a container with a pharmacy label that matches the doctor's orders. If your child has a severe allergy, the needed form will be sent separately by the school nurse.

Student safety is the primary focus of our district's medication procedures and we appreciate your support. If you have any questions or concerns, please call 509-354-2700 or stop by the school office.

- Please pick up a copy of the medication/treatment order(s) before the last day of school and deliver to the supervisor of the summer program.
- Students must have a medication/treatment order in place by the first day of the summer program.
- If your child will need assistance with a treatment (diabetes, nebulizer, VNS, etc.) during a summer program, please contact your school nurse or 354-7298, as soon as possible.
- A new medication/treatment order, signed by parents and a licensed health provider is needed if orders will change for summer.
