By signing below, I understand that:

- When working in the concession stand either at Joe Albi Stadium or Ferris High School, I am representing the Ferris Music Parent's Association and Ferris High School in a business environment.
- Students and parents will participate in the work of the concessions including set up and clean up and that all workers in the concession stand are being paid equally and should share work equally.
- All workers in the concession stand must have a Spokane Regional Health District Food Handler's Permit on file with the Ferris Music Parent's Association.
- Students and parents will be assigned shifts and receive notification of their shifts via an email to their parents email address. If a student or parent is unable to fulfill their shift requirement they must give at least 24 hour notice to the concession scheduler in order to find a replacement. DO NOT trade shifts. All shift changes must happen through the concession scheduler.
- Should a parent or student be a "NO-SHOW" for their shift, they forfeit the opportunity for future shifts.
- Parents and students must step outside the concession stand to use cell phones.
- Partaking of food or beverage (water is an exception) in the concession stand is prohibited by the Spokane Regional Health District.
