School Bus Rider Information for 2016-2017

Eligible Bus Rider

Students whose primary, registered address is outside the established one-mile walk radius and within the school's attendance area, are eligible for school bus transportation.

Bus Stop Assignments

Each eligible rider will be assigned to one school bus stop for pick up and drop based on the student's registered home address. For more information on bus stops, go to:

Alternate Address for Pick Up/Drop Off – (daycare, split custody, relative, etc)

Your student may be served at an alternate pick up and/or drop off when:

1. Spokane Public Schools has received a completed Before & After School Transportation Request (see above), AND...
2. The requested alternate address is within the eligible bussing area of your student's school.

Rules of Riding the School Bus

Riding the school bus is a privilege. Riders must follow the rules of conduct, which are available at any school or found online at www.spokaneschools.org/page/1841.

Additional Information

Authorized riders may not invite others to ride on the bus with them. Authorized riders may not access another school bus or stop without the form mentioned above for alternate address. Elementary Students **DO NOT** need to register to ride the bus.

All students grades K-8 will have assigned seating while on the bus. Students grades 9-12 will not have assigned seating unless their behavior deems it necessary.

Secondary students (7-12) will need to sign up for the school bus in order to be eligible to ride to and from school and/or activities. Students who have not signed up for bussing will not be authorized to board the bus.
